Considerations

As you will be traveling to Mallorca from another country, , it is mandatory to fill out and sign the <u>FCS form</u> associated with your trip, regardless of your nationality, age or any other consideration. You can find information about the new sanitary control process <u>here</u>

As of November 23rd, 2020, all passengers who come from a high-risk country in relation to the SARS-CoV-2 coronavirus, in order to enter Spain, **MUST show a certificate with a NEGATIVE PCR result (COVID-19 RT-PCR), carried out in the 72h prior to your arrival.** You can consult the list of risk countries in this link.

The Regional Ministry for Health and Consumer Affairs has drawn up a resolution to strengthen the measures designed to prevent the propagation of COVID-19, thus, the use of face masks is mandatory in public. It is recommended to use mask in private gatherings. This includes buildings with a public use, and places that provides any service to the public. Exceptions, however, include pools, beaches, and dining establishments when eating and drinking. It is recommended to use mask in private gatherings too.
